# Chairman's Report

National Enterprises Limited recorded after-tax profits of **\$267.6 million** for the six months ended **September 30, 2011** compared with after-tax profits of **\$313.5 million** posted for the corresponding six months in 2010. Earnings per share for the period stood at **45 cents** as against **51 cents** in the six months to **September 2010**.

Given the composition of NEL's investment portfolio, conditions in global energy and commodity markets as well as domestic factors have posed challenges for some of its investee companies resulting in this decline in profitability at the half-year. Notwithstanding this decline, the actual dividend flows received by NEL increased by **75 percent** in the six months to **September 2011** compared with receipts in the corresponding period in **2010** and overall expectations for the second half of the financial year are positive.

NEL has continued to perform strongly on the domestic Stock Exchange. At **September 30, 2011** the share price, after peaking at **\$16.02** two weeks earlier, was **\$15.99** with the share having opened the year on **January 3, 2011** at **\$10.28**. This represents a **55.5 percent** increase.

On the basis of NEL's performance to date, the directors have declared an interim dividend of **20 cents** a share for the financial year ending **March 31, 2012**. This dividend will be paid on **December 16, 2011**.
